

Competition File Uploads

Overview

Students may upload up to three files, one being a video, for any competition configured in the tool. Once all entries have been submitted, competition judges will then be able to score each student after logging in with a judge account.

File Uploads

Students can make one submission per event per email address. The file upload page is located at <https://patriots-ttc.org/competition-file-upload/>. Students should enter their full name, accurate email address, choose the correct competition, files, and enter the file upload key. The default file upload passkey is the same as the email address used in the submission.

Competition File Upload

Welcome to the Patriots Competitions File Upload page. This page is used strictly for events that require video and/or other documents to compete. All files uploaded should be of your own creation and "G" rated. Copyright and Trademarked files are NOT allowed.

Patriots will give you a pass key in order to upload files. The key is case sensitive. If you are uploading images, you must compress your file(s) with a free tool such as [tinypng](#) before uploading. You are allowed only one submission for each event.

Any combination of files can be submitted. Anyone needing to resubmit their files must go through BestBetMedia support to have their old entries removed first.

Students do not have to be logged in to make a submission. Maximum upload size is 64MB.
